
#### Brief history of a collector

Jaap Best (1912 – 2002) had been enchanted by the circus and collected circus posters since early childhood. Fascinated by circuses such as Circus Wilhelm Hagenbeck and Circus Cory Althoff, it was no surprise he joined the circus professionally; in 1947 he started working for the Karl Strassburger Circus as an administrative assistant and from the 1960s onwards he also worked at the Williams-Althoff, the Wiener Eisrevue, Circus Harry Belli and the Berliner Eisrevue. It was a perfect combination; he collected and administered the objects he was passionate about.

In 1964, Best was able to purchase the spectacular collection of Erdwin Schirmer, former acrobat and circus collector from the early days. This magnificent and unique collection included over 3500 well-preserved coloured lithographic posters by German printer Friedländer, based in Hamburg. Adolph Friedländer (1851-1904) and sons produced a staggering number of almost 10.000 posters between 1872 and 1935, and were renowned for portraying circus artists, magicians, vaudeville, theatre and entertainment acts.

During the later years of his life, Jaap and his wife started the Jaap Best Circus Archive Foundation, which, after Best's death, bequeathed his entire collection to the Teylers Museum in Haarlem. In 2016, the collection was trusted to the Allard Pierson's Institute, where it would be accommodated under the Theater collection's catalogue. Our selection presents the first of two auctions with doublets from this collection; many of them likely to be the only other surviving copies.





#### **Circuses and Acts**

The legendary circuses that are presented in our catalogue all have their unique historic character. Circus Hagenbeck was particularly known as the founder of the modern day zoos with more natural enclosures for the animals, but also for the 'Human Zoos' exhibiting 'purely natural' population groups such as the Nubians. Circus Busch, now Busch-Roland, is world-renowned for its permanent circular building home-based in Berlin, which could seat almost 4500 people and host mega-shows. Swiss Circus Knie is famous for their horse dressage shows, using Frisian, Andalusian or Lipizzan horses. Finally, circus Sarrasani (Dresden) was known for its use of modern technology making spectacular acts with e.g. cars, airplanes, boats and projections. During WWI, the circus was turned into a live-action military War theatre, showing the invasion of Belgium by the Germans in 1914, submarine warfare in the First Battle of the Masurian Lakes for which the entire ring was flooded, and even the bombing of London with zeppelins.

Obviously, some posters portray scenes and themes that would be rejected nowadays: 'freakshows' showing dwarfs and albinos 'on display', human zoos which exhibited indigenous people seen from western perspective, rare and wild animals doing tricks and performing in shows. Beside these intriguing subjects, the posters also portray great shows of balance, song & dance, transformations acts and magicians that enticed public to come and see the wonders of the world.

It is our great pleasure to present these wonderful billboards of circus and entertainment history.

However, he was mostly remembered for his unusual looks: Karl was born with severe albinism, and intertwined his act and his physical features of a snow white skin, white hair and pink eyes into a mythological persona: the "Ice King". See also lot nos. 3031, 3032 and 3034.

The weight of this wheel was further enhanced with three men holding on to it. He was known as the "strongest man in the world" and became a folk hero for Jews in Eastern Europe.

The performance ended with the "Rough-Riders" act, where the women were dressed in military uniform with rifles.
